- Information on ECHO Clinic (Extension for Community Healthcare Outcomes): Oregon ACT teams are invited to participate in this effort to provide ongoing consultation and support professional development efforts.

- Oregon State Hospital staff discussion of hospital referral process
 - This was cancelled by the OSH hospital staff. In lieu of this item a discussion was held about risk factors in referrals, checking multiple sources, having full information to make the safest determination possible when deciding if individual referrals are accepted. Area ACT teams discussed issues with staff safety and import of catching this on the front end at admission time.
