

ACT Capacity Estimates (11/26/19)

Based on the population estimates for ACT Capacity and Expansion needs, the table below provides a current estimate of the number of adults over age 18 living in each county, the ACT capacity for the agencies serving Oregon Counties, the number of ACT clients enrolled and the unmet need. Counties highlighted in BOLD represent counties where the unmet need for the number of individuals who need ACT services is greater than 100. These counties are: Clackamas, Lane, Marion, Multnomah and Washington. ACT expansion should also be considered in Jackson County and Deschutes County.
