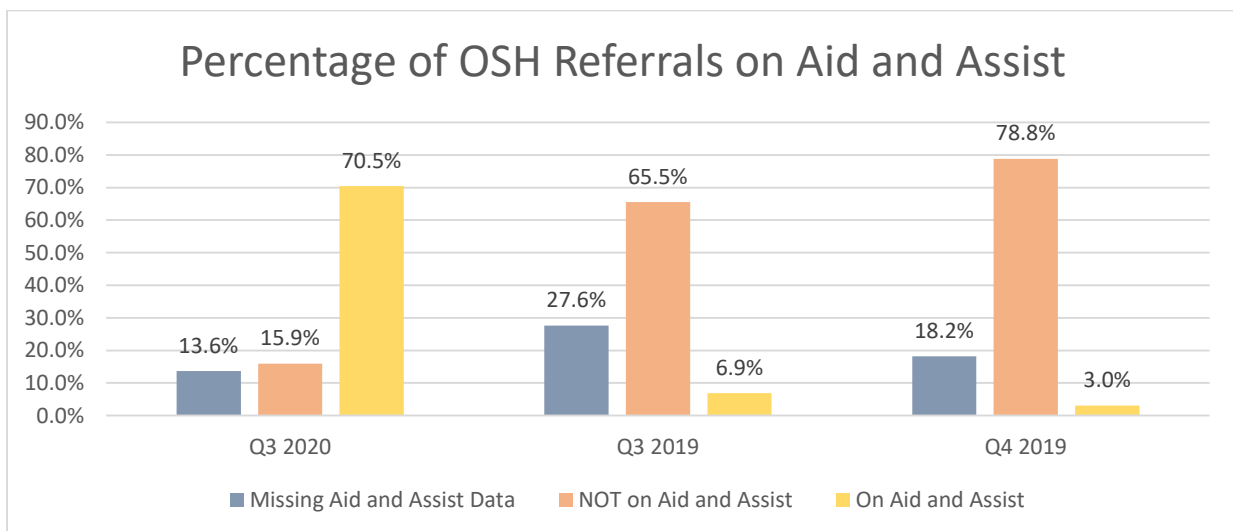

Of the 44 referrals made to ACT from the Oregon State Hospital in Q3 2020, 31 (70.5%) were on Aid and Assist. The remaining 13 referrals were either not on Aid and Assist or they were missing Aid and Assist data.

By comparison, in Q3 2019, 29 referrals were made from OSH with 2 (6.9%) being on Aid and Assist. In Q4 2019, 33 referrals were made from OSH with 1 (3%) being on Aid and Assist.
